

Clear Cell Sarcoma of the Patellar Tendon: Resection and Reconstruction With Bone-Patellar Tendon-Bone Allograft

This video reviews the case presentation of an 18-year-old man with a clear cell sarcoma of the patellar tendon. The process of wide resection followed by reconstruction with the use of a bone-patellar tendon-bone allograft fixed with headless compression screws is described. A gastrocnemius flap was used to cover the allograft, and partial-thickness skin grafts were used. During follow-up, it was determined that a good functional result was achieved. Given the unusual nature of the case, very few videos show this technique or its results.
