## **Arthroscopic Fixation of Acetabular Rim Fracture**

Acetabular rim fractures occasionally occur in patients with femoroacetabular impingement. This video shows arthroscopic fixation of an acetabular rim fracture in a patient with femoroacetabular impingement, including a cam-type deformity, a labral tear, and subspine impingement, which are managed via femoral osteochondroplasty, labral repair, and acetabuloplasty, respectively. Indications and considerations for acetabular rim fixation and technical pearls are discussed. In the patient in this video, a headless compression screw was used for rim fixation, which does not require a washer and may leave more surface area available for labral repair.
