

Radical Resection and Limb-Sparing Reconstruction of the Distal Femur for a Fibroblastic Osteosarcoma

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This is a case of a 15-year-old female patient who presented with right knee pain. Further investigation revealed an 87x46mm lesion in the distal femur. Biopsy confirmed the diagnosis of a fibroblastic osteosarcoma. The patient underwent a radical resection and limb-sparing reconstruction of the distal femur. There were no neurovascular complications and postoperatively she is recovering well.
