Resection of a Plexiform Neurofibroma

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This is a case of a 59-year-old male who presented with severe pain and neurofibromatosis as well as a large underlying mass on the left lower extremity with a history of a tumor removal done previously in the area. Further investigation revealed a 11 x 3 x 20 cm abnormality in the left knee. A core needle biopsy indicated a plexiform neurofibroma. The patient underwent a radical resection of a 50 cm mass in the left lower extremity. There were no neurovascular complications and postoperatively he is recovering well.
