

Radical Resection of a Chondrosarcoma of the Pubic Symphysis

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This is a 58 year old female patient with a history of multicentric/metastatic extraskeletal chondrosarcoma on her right distal stump who presented with a soft tissue sarcoma in her suprapubic region. MRI demonstrated a 4.6 x 3.2 x 2.9 cm lesion superior to the pubic symphysis. Biopsy of the lesion demonstrated an atypical cartilaginous tumor, compatible with the patients history of a chondrosarcoma. The patient underwent a radical resection of the chondrosarcoma. There were no neurovascular complications and the patient tolerated the procedure well.
