Pediatric Monteggia: The Problem of Plastic Deformation

A classic Monteggia fracture is characterized by an ulnar fracture leading to dislocation of the radial head. However, in the pediatric population this injury can also occur without an apparent ulnar fracture and instead, due to plastic deformation of the ulna. Here we illustrate a case of the injury pattern fixed with osteotomy and pinning.
