

The Modified L'Episcopo Procedure With Reverse Total Shoulder Arthroplasty

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This video details the presentation, management, and postoperative outcomes of a 59-year-old man with right shoulder pain and symptoms suggestive of a rotator cuff tear with considerable lack of external rotation. Surgical management consisted of reverse total shoulder arthroplasty with a modified L'Episcopo procedure. The procedure was performed to restore shoulder function and considerably increase external rotation.
